A & AS-LEVEL EXAM RESULTS 2010

The most notable results this year were from our A-level students, which overall were the best we have ever had.

TOP A-LEVEL STUDENTS

This year saw the introduction of the new A* grade for upper-sixth students in the A2-level exams. The A* grade is awarded to students who achieve marks higher than 90%.

We congratulate **Neil Parsons** and **Chanda Chungu** who each obtained two A* grades in Chemistry & Physics and Geography & Business Studies respectively. Neil is also the first student in our history to achieve 4 grade A's in his A-levels.
