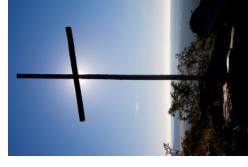

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The Sixth Form is now a thriving part of the Chengelo School with the Sixth Form students playing a leading role in every aspect of school life. Our aim is to ensure that as many students as possible obtain grades which give access to the world's best universities. Our experience has shown that the best universities are looking for applicants who have the highest academic qualifications combined with a rounded education.

AS / A-Levels

Whilst all universities recognise IGCSE, most have entry criteria which require qualifications at a higher level. For this reason Chengelo offers a two year A-level programme to equip students with the skills needed to study at the highest level. We develop the ability to cope with rigorous academic demands and undertake independent research. Students gain competence in ICT and study skills and build a framework to analyse ideas critically from a Christian perspective. A one year AS-level course is also available and for students intending to apply to American universities we offer SAT exams.

Students at Chengelo Sixth Form are entered for the University of Cambridge International Examinations at AS and A-level.



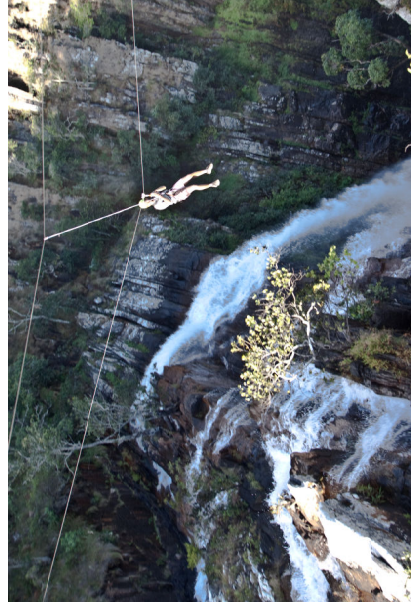
We currently offer the following subjects:

In recent years our students' pass rate has been over 90% with over 60% of passes being grade C and above—significantly higher than the world average.

More than just an Academic Programme

Unlike other Sixth Forms which concentrate purely on academic study, at Chengelo, we focus on developing maturity and depth of character. Students have the opportunity to gain the prestigious International Youth Award at Gold level, play a variety of sports and take part in the outdoor programme at 'Ndubaluba', Chengelo's own outdoor centre. We also have a programme of leadership training and many of the Sixth Form students become Prefects giving them the opportunity to put into practice the skills they have learned.



The 'feel' of the Sixth Form is substantially different to that of a secondary school. Working in smaller groups with dedicated, experienced and highly qualified teaching staff helps to ensure success, whilst relationships with staff changes to one of partnership, trust and mutual respect. Students are assigned a Tutor to care for pastoral needs and they receive individual careers guidance and the opportunity to go on industrial tours to ensure that they make the right choices and achieve their full potential.

Excellent Facilities



In the Sixth Form students enjoy spacious, purpose built accommodation and facilities, including the 'university style' single study bedrooms. The Sixth Form centre has classrooms for lessons, a computer area with access to email and the internet and a common room which has facilities for socialising and recreation.
